Asians are one of the fastest growing ethnic groups in America, with Georgia having one of the fastest growing Asian American populations in the US, and a population of well over 200,000 in the Metro Atlanta area. In light of this growth, it is clear that there is a need for culturally-sensitive and language-appropriate counseling services for the Asian and Asian American population, and yet such services have been lacking in Atlanta, and even in most of the United States. This is where **ACCESS** comes in. Not only have we been serving to fill this need for culturally-sensitive and language-appropriate counseling services, but as part of our mission to provide affordable services, we also have a sliding scale discount based on income and ability to pay. We have given numerous educational workshops and seminars to various groups in the area, and we have counseled a variety of individuals, couples, and families.

On **Saturday, November 7th**, we will be hosting our 2015 Fundraising Dinner Gala, with the theme "A Road Less Traveled." This event will feature a gourmet Chinese banquet, door prizes, and special guest speaker Paul Tokunaga, Vice-President and Director of Strategic Ministries for InterVarsity Christian Fellowship. - To provide referral information about other community health and social service resources

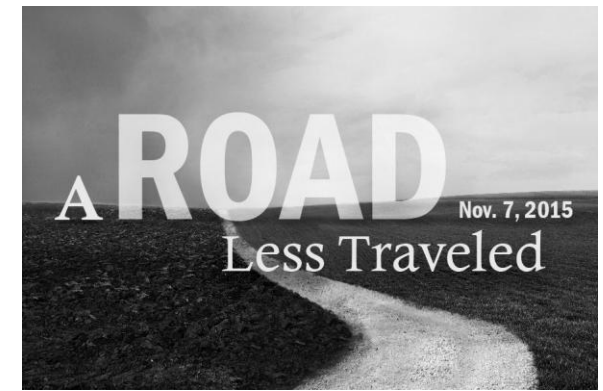
