Greetings on behalf of the Board of Directors and staff of *Asian Christian Counseling & Educational Seminar Services, Inc.* (ACCESS)! For those of you who are not familiar with us, we are a non-profit counseling service incorporated August 2004, serving the Greater Atlanta community for over six years now.

While our services are open to people of all ethnicities and religions, our mission is focused on addressing the mental health needs of the Asian and Asian American population in the Greater Atlanta area by providing affordable and accessible professional counseling and psychotherapy, as well as preventive and educational services. Through such services, we seek to offer hope and guidance for positive personal change in order to restore broken relationships, strengthen families, promote emotional healing, and enhance individual lives and interpersonal relationships.

Asians are one of the fastest growing ethnic groups in America, with Georgia having one of the fastest growing Asian American populations in the US, and a population of well over 200,000 in the Metro Atlanta area. In light of this growth, it is clear that there is a need for culturally-sensitive and language-appropriate counseling services for the Asian and Asian American population, and yet such services have been lacking in Atlanta, and even in most of the United States. This is where **ACCESS** comes in. In September 2005 we moved into our offices in Doraville, and last fall we opened a satellite office in Johns Creek to be more accessible to the many Asians who live in the suburbs north of Atlanta. As part of our mission to provide services that are affordable, we have a sliding scale discount based on income and ability to pay. We have given numerous educational workshops and seminars to various groups in the area, and we have counseled a variety of individuals, couples, and families.

On **Saturday, November 6th**, we will be hosting our 2010 Fall Fundraising Dinner, with the theme "Building Up the Family, Building Up the Community." This event will feature a gourmet Chinese banquet with live music, and a special guest speaker Mr. Warren Wen of Liu & Associates, as well as door prizes and possibly another great Hawaiian vacation raffle prize!
